Confirmation Information

Check-In: Is from 8:30-9:00 a.m. on Monday, August 3. DAY staff will meet students in the parking lot and escort them to the dance studio. *A short orientation is from 9:00-9:15 am, parents do not have to be present.*

What Time Daily: Classes will begin promptly at 9 am, concluding at noon. Staffing is not available for early arrival or late pick-up. For safety of all participants, please be prompt when dropping off and picking up your children. *If you have an emergency and/or expect you will be late, please call Cher Carnell, Program Director at (360) 224-9687 to make arrangements.*

Where: Classes are held in Carver 60. From the parking lot (11G), walk east past College Hall (first building on your right) to Carver Gym (second building on right).

What to Wear: Comfortable clothing that you can dance in! (No jeans; recommended are leotards and tights, leggings and long shirts, sweats, or long shorts). Ballet slippers are preferred for ballet, socks are acceptable footwear for all other classes. Hair should be controlled and off the face.

What to Bring: A small snack for break-time.

Performance: Our program will culminate with an exciting performance, featuring all participants, at 7:00, Friday, August 21, in the Old Main Theatre on campus. Family and friends are invited to attend this free performance!! More information will be given in classes.

How to Get There: Enter campus from Bill McDonald Parkway. Turn right on 21st St. Turn left on West College Way. Turn right on Highland Dr. Follow Highland to High St. Follow High St. to the Performing Arts Center (#16 on the campus map).

Daily Parking: The unload and load permit below is for parking lot 14G (located before you reach the Performing Arts Center), please place it on the dashboard of your vehicle to drop-off and pick-up your child.

Parking for Monday Check-in/Orientation: Free parking is available in the “C” (gravel) lots or you can purchase a parking permit for Lot 14G at the Parking Office on 21st Street for Monday check-in and orientation.

Parking for Culminating Performance: Free parking is available in “C” (gravel) lots, use the blue pay box in the parking lots, or purchase a permit at the Parking Office during office hours.
