Information for Commuter (Day Camp) Students – High School Session

Welcome to Western Washington University and SPY (Summer Programs for Youth). We have a week full of adventures planned for you! Please keep this for reference during your student's program week.

Confirmation Information

Monday Arrival: Students check in between **8:00am and 8:30am** on the following Mondays in the lobby of Communications Facility 115 (#30 on the campus map): **July 20**. Orientation is from 8:30-9:00 a.m.

Daily Arrival: Tuesdays through Fridays, students report to Communications Facility 115 by 9:00 a.m., unless otherwise notified for early departure field trips. **Please be on time.** Our schedule is full and punctuality is important for the level of learning we have planned for you. If you are late for a field trip, you will be left behind for the day. No exceptions will be made.

Daily Dismissal: Students will be dismissed promptly at 5:00 p.m. in Communications Facility 115. To ensure the safety of participants, all students must be signed out by authorized staff at the conclusion of each day. If you are to walk, ride a bus, or bike home, you must have written authorization from your parent at check-in. In that case, you may sign yourself out daily with program staff.

For your safety and well-being, please be aware that staff is not available for supervision before 8:45 a.m. Tuesday-Friday or after 5:15 p.m. Monday-Thursday.

Closing Assembly: All students, their families and friends are invited to attend the Closing Assembly on Friday from 2:30 to 3:30 p.m. in Arntzen Hall 04 (#26 on the campus map). At this time, presentations, a slide show, and demonstrations will allow students to share highlights of their program activities with family and friends. At the conclusion, parents must check-out their student with SPY staff.

What to Wear: Dress is casual and suited for summer weather, but must be appropriate to an academic setting.

What to Bring Daily: Backpack, 3-ring binder, pencils, pens are required. Cameras are welcome. *Students are to bring their swimsuit and a towel on Wednesday.*

- **FIELD TRIPS:** pack warm, waterproof, windproof clothing, sunscreen, sunglasses, water bottles, and extra shoes in case of wet weather.

Parking: A 20 minute drop-off and pick up permit is printable below and valid Monday through Friday in parking lot **19G**. A **19G permit for Friday's closing assembly** will be given to you at check-in.

Driving Directions: Take exit 252 from I-5. Follow signs to WWU. Take Bill McDonald Parkway to South College Drive and turn right. Turn right at West College Way. Follow the "SPY" directional signs to parking lot 19G and Communications Facility 115 or Arntzen Hall 04.
