### CONFIRMATION INFORMATION

**Check-In:** Is from 12:30-1:00 PM. on Monday, June 22. SYTI staff will meet students in the parking lot and escort them to the studio. Please note that there will be a brief introduction from 1:00-1:30 PM. *Parents do not have to be present.*

**What Time:** Class is held Monday through Friday, **starting promptly at 1:00 PM and concluding at 4:00 PM.** Staffing is not available for early arrival or late pick-up. For the safety of all participants, please be prompt when dropping off and picking up your children. **If you have an emergency and/or expect you will be late,** please call **Deborah Currier, Program Director at 360-650-2387 or 360-303-6347,** to make arrangements.

**Where:** Theatre studio rooms inside the Performing Arts Center.

**What Should a Theatre Artist Wear:** Students should **wear comfortable clothes** (casual pants/shorts, sweatshirts/ t-shirts) and shoes that allow them to move quickly and freely. **Please, no flip-flops or skirts.**

**What to Bring:** Students should bring a small snack (juice and crackers, a piece of fruit, or granola bar) for break-time.

**The Final Performance:** The program will conclude with two spectacular final performances in the Old Main Theatre on campus (directions will be given out during the institute). The first performance will immediately follow the last day of camp, Friday July 10 at 7:30 pm in Old main Theater. Family and friends are all invited to the free performance! More information will come home during the institute. **Student's attendance at the performance is mandatory.**

**School House Rock, Live!:** If you have registered for this option, rehearsals are from 5:30-8:00 PM, Monday through Friday July 6-22. In the Old Main Theater.

**School House Rock, Live! Performances** are **Jul 23, 24, 25, 29, 30, 31 and Aug 1 @ 7:30 PM and July 26 and Aug 2 @ 2 PM** in the Old Main Theatre. Strike of the show will happen immediately following the final matinee performance on Aug 2 – everyone is expected to be at strike, which should last no more than 2 hours.

### PARENTS INFORMATION

**How Do I Get There:** Enter campus from Bill McDonald Parkway. Turn right on 21<sup>st</sup> St. Turn left on West College Way. Turn right on Highland Dr. Follow Highland to High St. Follow High St to the Performing Arts Center (#16 on the map)

**Daily Parking:** The unload and load permit below is for parking lot 14G (located before you reach the Performing Arts Center), please place it on the dashboard of your vehicle to drop-off and pick-up your child.

**Parking for Monday Check-in/Introduction:** Free parking is available in the "C" (gravel) lots or you can purchase a parking permit for Lot 14G at the Parking Office on 21<sup>st</sup> Street for Monday check-in and orientation.

**Parking for Final Performance:** Free parking is available in the “C” (gravel) lots, use the blue pay box in parking lots or purchase a permit at the Parking Office during office hours.
