Parking:             Park in the Municipal Court lot off of "C" Street. Court is in  
session on the 18<sup>th</sup> so please use the northeast half of the lot to

sidewalk around the north side of the building to the Information  
Technology Services Department entrance off of Halleck Street.

Driving:              Stay on I-5 to exit 254.

If coming from the south, you will exit onto Iowa Street. Take a  
left and head west on Iowa for two blocks to the intersection with James and State  
Streets. Angle left onto N. State, proceed a couple of blocks and angle right onto Ohio  
Street. If you came from the north, you exited I-5 directly onto Ohio Street and after a  
couple of blocks you are at the same State St. / Ohio St. intersection. In either case, go  
west on Ohio about six blocks to its ending at Cornwall. Cross that intersection and  
angle right onto Halleck Street. Continue on Halleck for about five blocks. The meeting  
site is in the Court Building on your left between "B" and "C" streets. The parking area is  
on the left between "C" and "D" Streets (see parking instructions above).
