

Washington Federation of State Employees (WFSE)

Bargaining Unit A (BUA)

This bargaining unit represents a unit of non-supervisory classified employees in office-clerical positions.

Bargaining Unit B (BUB)

This bargaining unit represents a unit of non-supervisory classified employees in custodial, maintenance, operations, grounds, campus police, parking, steam plant, mail services, and warehouse positions.

Bargaining Unit E (BUE)

This bargaining unit represents a unit of supervisory classified employees in custodial, maintenance, operations, grounds, campus police, parking, steam plant, mail services, and warehouse positions.

Temporary Employees

Temporary employees who work in a classification represented by one of the units described above and who work more than 350 hours in any 12 month consecutive period are represented.

Public School Employees (PSE)

Professional and Technical Employees (PTE)

This bargaining unit represents a unit of non-supervisory professional and technical classified employees.

Bargaining Unit D (BUD)

This bargaining unit is comprised of two separate units: supervisors and non-supervisors. The non-supervisory unit represents classified employees who oversee student workers performing office-clerical and administrative support functions. The supervisory unit represents classified employees who supervise classified employees performing office-clerical and administrative support functions.

Temporary Employees

Temporary employees who work in a classification represented by one of the units described above and who work more than 350 hours in any 12 month consecutive period are represented.
